REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

Network Infrastructure Upgrade

The purpose of this Request for Proposal (RFP) is to solicit sealed proposals to establish a contract through fair and competitive negotiations for a Network Infrastructure Upgrade. The equipment requested in this document is part of the E-Rate filings for the Scott County School District #2 for the 2015 funding year.
