A. Consideration of the Sale of the Boatman Road Property

Dr. Slaton explained that the selling of the property on Boatman Road was part of our financial recovery plan since the spring of 2024 and this sale will help meet our financial recovery goal sooner. Two appraisals were received on the property. One for 1.5 Million and the other 1.665 Million. Dr. Slaton and Dr. Neukam met with 4 real estate agents, and decided to list the property with Bridgewater Real Estate. There have been two offers made. One offer was 1.8 Million and requested several contingencies. The second offer was 1.7 Million and would be a cash transaction with no contingencies.

Dr. Slaton recommends accepting the offer of 1.7 from Scottsburg SR56 Partners LLC.
